# It takes place at Donald's house, in the library. 2X0.5 pt

2. Give the narrator's name and say how old he was when he met Donald for the first time.

Johnny. 0.5 pt

# He was seven years old when he met Donald for the first time. 1 pt

3. At what moment of the day does the scene take place? Justify your answer with two quotations.

in the evening, (after dinner time) 1 pt

• line 3: 'dinner dishes' 1 pt

lines 37/38: darkening summer evening. 1 pt

4. 'I should have shown you these' (line 12). What exactly does 'these' refer to?

these are photos of the narrator's mother. 2 pts

Read from line 14 to line 21.

5. a) What do 'I looked at her as if for the first time' and 'a slim small-breasted woman' reveal about the way the narrator considers his mother?

He doesn't consider her as his mother, but as an attractive young lady / stranger.

2X2 pts

b) Further down in the text, pick out a phrase confirming your answer.

lines 14/15 : 'I looked at her as if I were a groom in an arranged marriage contemplating his distant bride.' 2 pts

(ou line 42: 'this pretty young stranger.')

c) Why does the narrator see his mother that way?

She <u>died</u> the day he was born so he <u>never knew</u> her. <u>2X2 pts</u>

6. 'It was strange too ...... limber' (lines 19-21). What does the narrator realise about his father?

The narrator is surprised to discover his father <u>as a young man</u>, as <u>a man in love with</u> a woman. 2X2 pts

### From line 22 to line 33:

7. a) What are the three different things the narrator learns from Donald?

He learns that his father <u>asked Donald to take pictures of his mother</u>. She <u>came to Donald's house</u>. She <u>came several times</u>. (Accepter également: his mother, his father and Donald went on excursions together) 3X2 pts



b) Explain what's going on in the narrator's mind at that stage.

deduces that Donald was in love with his mother. 6 pts

He can feel his mother's presence in the house. He starts realising something strange has happened, picturing his mother in Donald's house (bonus pour without his father) and he can't help feeling strange about it.

#### Read from line 34 to the end

8. a) "'I offered the album to your father after she....' Donald said. 'But he didn't - said he couldn't bear to have it.'"

There are words left unsaid in these sentences. Find them and rewrite the sentences.

- 'I offered the album to your father after she **died'** Donald said. 'But he didn't **want / accept / take / it he** said he couldn't bear to have it. ' **1.5 pt**
- b) What is Donald's state of mind and how does the narrator interpret it?Donald is unable to pronounce the verb 'die'. He must be very <u>sad</u>, <u>remembering her death</u>. He

# 9. In your own words:

a) Say what this discovery represents in the narrator's life. (50 words) This discovery represents his first adult secret. He feels he is no longer a child. As he has understood the nature of the relationship between his mother and Donald, he feels very proud. What is more, he is pleased with being able to keep his secret. This discovery symbolizes a passage from childhood to adulthood.

Exiger quatre éléments. 4X2.5 pts

Bonus pour : the narrator shares a secret with his mother and is closer to her than he has ever been. +1 pt

b) Explain the change it caused in his relationship to his father.

It enabled him to understand / accept why his father was distant and unpleasant with him.

2X2 pts

10. How would you account for the father's attitude to his son? (30 / 40 words)

He may resent his son for being <u>responsible for his wife's death</u>. He may also suspect that <u>Johnny is not his son</u> but Donald's. 2X3 pts

Accepter également : he may be angry with his wife because he suspects she had an affair, and as Johnny looks like his mother, he is angry with him too.



11. Focus on the narrative.

To what extent do 'I remember' (lines 1-2) and 'I remind you' (line 39) justify the title of the book?

It's a <u>first person narrative</u> in which the narrator is talking <u>about himself</u> to <u>somebody</u> (you). He is <u>looking back on his past</u> (remember).

Exiger 3 éléments. 3X2 pts

12. Imagine the reasons that led Donald to show the narrator the album on that particular day. (100 words) 15 pts (5X3 pts)

Johnny being 13, he is <u>old enough to know the truth</u> about relationship between Donald and his mother.

He may feel some kind of <u>remorse and can't go on living with that secret;</u>
He may want the boy to feel <u>less concerned by his father's coldness</u> towards him;
Being a motherless child is not easy, and he may want <u>to help the narrator to build up</u> his identity;

Donald doesn't want to keep the album, perhaps because the memories are too painful.
